Ann Morris Martin Rector, 75, of Bowling Green, died at 7:15 a.m. Jan. 25, 2004, at her residence.

The Warren County native was a retired school teacher in the Warren County School System for 20 years and was co-owner of Rector's Cherry Reproduction. She was a graduate of North Warren High School, where she was salutatorian; a graduate of Bowling Green Business College and Bethel Women's College, where she was a member of Phi Theta Kappa; a graduate of Western Kentucky University with a bachelor's degree of science and a master of arts degree with a 4.0 grade-point average, recipient of a Lifetime of Teaching certificate for Kentucky; recipient of the Kentucky Mother of the Year Award in 1982; organized and was first president of the Louisville Road Homemakers Club; lifetime member of the PTA; volunteer for the American Cancer Society and 4-H; member of Jackson Grove Baptist Church, where she was a Sunday school teacher and active in WMU, Vacation Bible School and assistant pianist and organist; and member of the Kentucky Colonels. She was a daughter of the late Beckham Martin Sr. and Katie Morris Martin, who received the Kentucky Merit Mother Award in 1957. She was preceded in death by two brothers, Beckham Martin Jr. and Jimmy Martin.

Funeral will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Hardy & Son Funeral Home, Bowling Green chapel, with burial in Smiths Grove Cemetery. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. today and from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home.
