James Oliver Lonborg, born Jan. 26, 1932, died in Las Vegas, Dec. 14, 2005. Jim was born in Oakville, Wash., to Lloyd and Carolyn Lonborg. He was a graduate of Oakville High School, Centralia Junior College, and Washington State College. Earning a degree in physics, Jim was especially proud of his membership in Phi Beta Kappa. After working as a physicist at Sandia National Laboratories in Albuquerque, N.M., Jim became a career employee of the California Institute of Technology's Jet Propulsion Laboratory, NASA's headquarters for unmanned space exploration in Pasadena, Calif. During his 49-year association with the lab, Jim was honored to be able to contribute to every unmanned space flight since the program's inception. In 1983, he was recognized as the Centralia College Distinguished Alumnus of the Year award. Jim was preceded in death by his parents; and brother, George.
